EVALUATION SYSTEM

Students' performance is evaluated on the basis of following criteria:

Attendance

Attendance is a vital component of RPCCA's academic system as we believe that a student must be present inside the classroom on regular basis for effective teaching-learning process

Assignments

As per the guidelines of university, the institute conducts seminars & workshops. As a part of internal evaluation, students are also supposed to give presentations and assignments on specific topics assigned to them.

Mid-Semester Examinations

The purpose of mid-semester examinations is to prepare the students for University examinations in terms of structure/pattern of Question paper and time management during the written examination. It is generally conducted in the mid of the semester (after half the session is over) and includes approximately 60-70% of the total syllabus of the course.

Semester and (University) Examinations

These examinations are conducted by the University at the end of semester. It includes the examination of all the subjects which may be in the form of written examination conducting evaluation.
